

Requirements for the “Global Scholar Award” (graduation medal & certificate)

Graduate from DSU AND:

Complete **one** of the three paths:

PATH 1:

- Participate in a DSU or partner-sponsored, at least a semester-long, for-credit exchange or study abroad outside the U.S. and its territories.
- Complete 6 elective credits from the Global Studies emphasis/minor list at DSU (courses taken during the study abroad cannot count for these); OR one of the items listed under Path 3. [Waived for those completing a year exchange/study abroad]

PATH 2:

- Participate in a credit-bearing short or long-term study abroad; AND
- Complete a Global Studies emphasis/minor; AND
- Complete **one** of the following:
 - a. Senior Capstone project based conspicuously on global issues.
 - b. Complete an international internship.
 - c. Study a foreign language completing the 2020 college level (1020 level required for emphasis/minor).
 - d. For Global Studies minors complete 9 additional credits within Global Studies beyond the requirement for the minor; 6 additional credits for those completing Global Studies emphasis.
 - e. Participate in an additional credit or non-credit bearing study abroad.

PATH 3: *(can be completed without travel)*

- Complete the Global Studies minor/emphasis; AND
- Complete **two** of the following:
 - f. Senior Capstone project based conspicuously on global issues.
 - g. Complete an international internship.
 - h. Study a foreign language completing the 3060 college level (1020 level required for emphasis/minor).
 - i. For Global Studies minors complete 12 additional credits within Global Studies beyond the requirement for the minor; 9 additional credits for those completing Global Studies emphasis.
 - j. Participate in a credit or non-credit bearing study abroad.

Applicants must fill out an application form and submit it to the Global Education Office with supporting documentation/transcripts. The application is due one (1) month before the graduation date.
